Post graduate Courses / Training in Paediatrics & Child Health of BICH

- 1. **FCPS course in Paediatrics:** Twice in a year, in the month of January and July.
 - FCPS Part II: One year course plus 3 years residency training in any recognized hospitals in respective fields are required after passing FCPS Part-I examination in Paediatrics.
- 2. **MD** (Paediatric Medicine), MS (Paediatric Surgery) (3 years course): Two years training in respective field is required. Candidates are eligible to apply two years after their graduation.
- 3. **DCH** (one year course): 1 year Residency training in Paediatric Medicine in recognized Hospitals is required to apply in this course, This course is once in a year in the month of July.
- 4. Three months certificate course in Paediatrics.
- 5. 15 days Intensive Course for MCPS.
- 6. **B.Sc in Health Technology (Laboratory**: 4 years course): Candidates are eligible to apply after passing S.S.C & H.S.C or equivalent with an average grade point 7.00 (minimum 3.50 in each examination).
- 7. Integrated Management of Childhood Illness (IMCI) Training.
- 8. Palli Shishu Rural Health Training.

Admission eligibility for foreign students to be submitted with application

- 1. Foreign students have to collect NOC (No Objection Certificate) from their respective Mission / Embassy in Bangladesh and other relevant organizations.
- 2. Their MBBS / equivalent certificate / degree will be required to get equivalency from BMDC (Bangladesh Medical & Dental Council).
